Michael L. Muncy, 54, of Indianapolis, passed away March 25, 2016. He was born October 8, 1961 in Harlan, KY, to Terry and Anna Ball Muncy. Mike was a graduate of Warren Central High School. He married Terry Arthur March 24, 1984, spring boarding three decades of love, laughter, and family. Mike was employed at the Indianapolis Star as the General Foreman of the Electric Shop, and a proud member of IBEW Local #481. Mike loved photography, which he helped teach to a niece. He loved music, which he taught to his sons and played with many different family members. He traveled, often with his wife. He also enjoyed independent filmmaking, a hobby acquired from his father and a nephew. Above all else, he was an excellent human being.
