Nancy Sue Zeigler Ohrn Gilson, 84, of Indianapolis, passed away December 7, 2023. She was born December 4, 1939 in Indianapolis, Indiana to the late John M. Zeigler and Ruth I. Miller Zeigler. Nancy was a graduate of Shortridge High School, Class of 1957. She married her first husband, Richard B. Ohrn, and he preceded her in death December 1990.
