



## Norval A. Johannessohn

March 29, 1928 - May 13, 2018

Norval A. Johannessohn, 90, of Indianapolis, passed away May 13, 2018. He was born March 29, 1928 in Borup, MN, to the late Carl J. and Augusta P. Johannessohn. Norval was a graduate of Borup High School, MN, and received his Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering from North Dakota State University. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Air Force as a radio operator/repairman during the Korean Conflict. He married LaDonna Symonds in 1955, and was employed as an Electrical Engineer for Naval Avionics (now known as Raytheon) for 30 years, retiring in 1986.
