Oliver "Ollie" Z. Bondy, 82, of Indianapolis, passed away June 14, 2020. He was born July 15, 1937 in Indianapolis to the late Charles Z. Bondy and Alma Maye Reed Bondy. Ollie graduated from Howe High School, Class of 1955 and attended Indiana Central University and Butler University. He proudly served his country in the United States Army from 1960 until 1962. Ollie was an assembly line inspector with the Chrysler Corporation-Shadeland Plant and Kokomo Transmission Plant for 30 years, retiring in 1993. In retirement, he enjoyed traveling with his wife and was an avid fisherman. Ollie was a 50-year member of Masonic Lodge #140 in Oaklandon; a 40-year member of the Murat-Shrine and a member of the Scottish Rite. He was a native of the Miami Nation of Indians and was the great-great-great grandson of Frances Slocum.
