Paul Randall Angrick,

92, of Greenwood, passed away March 31, 2019. He was born in Indianapolis September 29, 1926 to the late Robert and Hettie Langley Angrick. Paul was a graduate of Arsenal Tech High School and received his Bachelor's Degree in Engineering from Purdue University. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII, and was recalled during the Korean War. Within the Navy, he was a member of the Seabees. Paul married Maxine Keller November 24, 1967, and she preceded him in death, January 30, 2016. He was self-employed in the field of electronics until 1984. Paul later worked for South Bend Controls and Johnson County REMC. He was a member of Southport Presbyterian Church, where he served as an Elder. He was also a member of the Masonic Order, volunteered in the Greenhouse of Greenwood Village Community and enjoyed spending time with his family.
