Paul L. Brady,

95, of Indianapolis, went to be with his Heavenly Father September 14, 2015. He was born December 2, 1919 in Dayton, OH. Paul attended Arsenal Technical High School. He served his country in the U.S. Army Air Corps during WWII in the Pacific Theatre. Paul married Alta M. Terkhorn, February 17, 1942, and she preceded him in death, January 8, 1990. He then married E. Elaine Neal, October 22, 1993, and she preceded him in death November 7, 2011.

Paul was employed as a machinist with the Allison Division of General Motors for 40 years, retiring in 1980. After retiring, Paul was a driver for Shirley Brothers Mortuaries for many years. He was a longtime member of Brookside United Methodist Church. Paul was a member of Brookside Masonic Lodge #720 F. & A.M., the Scottish Rite and the Murat Shrine.
