April 30, 1919 - March 16, 2010

Five weeks following the death of Paul's beloved wife, Carol, the two were reunited on March 16, 2010, when Paul passed away at the age of 90. He was born on April 30, 1919, in Danville, Indiana, to the late Clyde and Roxie Catron. Paul was a Navy veteran of World War II. He was employed by John H. Payne Associates, Inc., for 38 years, retiring in 1991. Paul served as a deacon and elder of Eastminster United Presbyterian Church, which later merged with Irvington Presbyterian Church.
