81, of Indianapolis, passed away November 8, 2020. He was born December 18, 1938 in Indianapolis, Indiana to Paul J. Sr., MD and Marguerite (Ward) Fouts. Paul graduated from Culver Military Academy, attended Hanover College, and graduated from Butler University with a Bachelor's Degree in accounting. He served his country as a member of the United States Army Reserves and received an Honorable Discharge. His career as a CPA spanned more than 50 years including positions at Roy Pile Firm; Finn & Company; and Fouts & Co LLC, among others. For the past four years he also served as a consultant at Marietta CPAs. 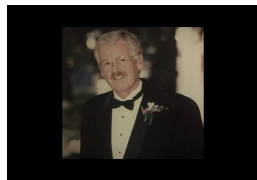
