Paul J. McDuff, resident of Fishers and lifelong Hoosier, devoted husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather dies at 90. Paul was born to the late Mary Tierney and Henry McDuff on January 25, 1928. He was born and raised in Indianapolis, Indiana. Paul attended Butler College and was a founding member of the Young Democrats Club. When war broke out in Korea, Paul joined the Navy. After the war, Paul married the love of his life – Irene Adrian. Paul and Irene raised a family of six – five daughters and one son.

Paul worked at Stokely-Van Camp for 35 years as Manager of Sales and Inventory Accounting. An avid golfer, Paul regularly participated in the Stokely golf league. The annual Stokely summer picnic is remembered as the highlight of the summer by his children.

After Stokely was purchased by Quaker Oats, Paul worked for the State of Indiana Highway accounting department for 10 years. In retirement he was a licensed real estate agent, member of the Knights of Columbus #3433, and worked part-time at Cline, Farrell, Christie and Lee Law Firm.

Paul was very proud of his Irish heritage and St. Patrick's Day was always a festive celebration. One of his hobbies was to create a pictorial family history highlighting the lives and accomplishments of previous McDuff and Tierney generations and their contributions to Indiana and especially boxing. A devoted and lifelong Catholic, Paul and Irene have worshipped at St. Louis de

Montfort Parish in Fishers for over 26 years.

Paul is survived by his loving wife of 66 years, Irene; devoted father to his six children, Susan Sauter and husband Bill, Nancy Stamm and husband Jeff, Jane Steel and husband Tom Buckmaster, Sharon Nicholls and husband Don, Beth Rogers and husband Vic and Tim McDuff and wife Nieves; 16 grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
