Paul Street, 63, of Indianapolis, passed away Sunday, December 9, 2007. Paul was a lifelong resident of Indiana graduating from Noblesville High School, after which he received an associate degree in accounting from Indiana University. Early in his career, Paul had been a road manager for singers and musicians including Johnny Cash. He had also worked for both Cleverly and Lockhart Cadillac, as well as Hubler, Kennedy and Shadeland automobile dealerships. Paul at one time owned a custom van conversion business in Elkhart, IN and had been a co-owner of Brocato Limousine service and Butler Imports, both in Indianapolis. He was a national and international courier and had most recently been employed by Brothers Auto Parts. Paul was also a Kentucky Colonel. He was an amazing storyteller, jokester, and friend who loved bringing joy into the lives of others. Paul was known as the [Limo Man](#) to the [Make-A-Wish Foundation](#) kids. He is survived by his wife of 14 years, Margaret M. Martin Street; brother, David (Brenda) Street; and 2 siblings, and is preceded in death by his son, Christopher Street and his sister, Sarah Street.
