Paul T. Yanich,

87, of Indianapolis, passed away November 26, 2015. He was born March 11, 1928 to the late Daniel and Mary Kabaluk Yanich. Paul was a 1946 graduate of George Washington High School. He attended St. Mary's College Seminary, Rensselaer, IN, and Abbey of Our Lady of Gethsemani Monestary, Trappist, KY. Paul served his country in the U.S. Army during the Korean War and married Mary Lu Wilkins, who preceded him in death on December 24, 1988.

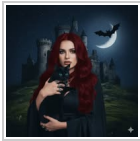
