Randall "Randy" James Barnes, 71, of Indianapolis, passed away March 26, 2021. He was born December 8, 1949 in Beech Grove, Indiana to the late Jesse R. and Gertrude Barnes. Randy was a graduate of Thomas Carr Howe High School. He was employed as an inventory control manager for CVS for over 40 years, retiring in 2012. Randy was a true humanitarian who sponsored three children from the Dominican Republic. He went on to build an elementary school there and all three children attended the Randy Barnes Elementary, and two became teachers. Randy loved animals, especially his dogs, gardening and playing the guitar. He was also a volunteer for the Indianapolis Zoo.
