



Raymond Ross Huffman

August 15, 1918 - March 29, 2012

Raymond R. Huffman, 93, of Indianapolis, passed away March 29, 2012. He was born August 15, 1918, in Washington, PA. to the late Ross H. and Iva Bebout Huffman. Ray graduated from Washington High School and enlisted in the U. S. Army Air Corps, retiring as 2nd Lieutenant in January 1946. Ray was employed with Jessop Steel Co. in 1946, and served in various sales positions until retiring December 31, 1985. He formed Green River Representatives along with two other retirees and served as V.P. until retiring the second time in 1991. In April, 1947, he married K. Jeanne Henderson, and was transferred to Indianapolis in October 1947, as a District Sales Manager. He was a member of Christ Presbyterian Church, former deacon and Past President of Prentice Presbyterian Church Little League Baseball. He was also a member and two-time Past Director of Hillcrest Country Club, Millersville Masonic Lodge #284, Scottish Rite Valley of Indianapolis, Murat Shrine, American Legion Post #470, a Kentucky Colonel, Indiana State Seniors Golf Association, Pebble Brook Golf Course, and USGA. Ray is survived by his three sons, Dennis R., Charles R. (Mary Dunlevy), and Gary N. (Mary Ann Myer), Huffman; seven grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.
