Renee C. Goeke, 89, of Carmel, passed away November 30, 2018. She was a wonderful wife and mother and a loving grandmother to her two grandsons. Renee had a love for life and enjoyed traveling and spending time with her family.

Renee is survived by her daughter, Lisa (Dan) McDaniel; and grandsons, Matthew (fiancé, Danielle Cox) of Denver, CO, and Nicholas McDaniel (fiancé, Melusine Mitchell) of Indianapolis. She was preceded in death by her husband, Paul Goeke, Jr.
