



## Rev. David Miles Sanders

August 29, 1939 - March 31, 2012

72 years of age, passed away March 31, 2012. He was born August 29, 1939, in Beech Grove, IN, to the late Napoleon Miles and Dorothy Mae Verhines Sanders. David graduated from Southport High School in the Class of 1959. He then married the love of his life, Gloria J. Archer, July 23, 1960. David worked for the Indianapolis International Airport and retired in September of 1989, as Operations Manager. He was a founding board member of the Indianapolis International Airport Kiwanis Club. David was a licensed minister of the United Pentecostal Church, International. In May 1970, he founded the First Apostolic Church in Morgantown, IN, and while serving as pastor was a member of the Morgantown Volunteer Fire Department. Rev. Sanders became pastor of Greater Life Tabernacle in Scottsburg, IN, in October of 1997, and served until his retirement in September of 2009. David also served the UPCI throughout his ministry as a District Sunday School Secretary in Indiana and Illinois, and was a Presbyter and the Harvestime Director in the Nebraska District. He was also a member of the Dale Carnegie Institute. David is survived by his loving wife of nearly 52 years, Gloria J. Sanders; his four devoted sons, Rev. Joseph A. Sanders (Dawn L.) of Scottsburg, IN, Rev. Jonathan A. Sanders (Debbie) of Honolulu, HI, Rev. James D. Sanders (Debi) of Mulberry, IN, and Rev. Jacob D.
