Rev. Floyd E. Matthews,

91, a lifelong resident of Indianapolis, passed away peacefully at his home and went to be with his Lord and Savior, June 3, 2021. Floyd was a 1949 graduate of Arsenal Tech High School, and received his B.A. and M.A. Degree from Indiana Bible College. Floyd proudly served his country in the U. S. Navy.
