Reverend Robert Haney, 72, of Indianapolis, passed away January 14, 2017. He was born March 25, 1944 in Nolan, West Virginia, to the late Harrison Haney and Georgia Hensley Haney. Robert retired after 43 years from the Ford Motor Company where he worked as a heat treat operator. He was also a Baptist minister from the age of 22. Robert was a member of the Old Regular Baptist Church and a moderator at Little Memory Old Regular Baptist Church in Batesville, Indiana. Robert enjoyed preaching in numerous churches throughout the Midwest, influencing the lives of young and old while bringing many of them to the Lord. In addition to preaching, Robert coached little league baseball for many years at Christian Park.

He was still crying and lingered in the church for awhile I believe he knew he would never be back. Ronnie and Regina took him to Kentucky to see Bro Otto and Sister Bea Newsom he was so happy he thanked them for letting him see them one more time. We will all miss Brother Robert his funny sayings like How Goest Thou Bro Baxter. He loved everyone. There are many more things that I could say about Brother Robert but time wont permit.
