Richard Lewis Simmons, aka "Dicky-Doo" or "Dick", 71, of Indianapolis left this earth Saturday, January 18, 2025 at Owensboro Health Regional Hospital. Dick was born January 18, 1954, in Indianapolis to the late Noah L. and Anna Marie Simmons. Dick didn't know a stranger and was the life of the party. 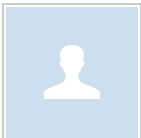
