Rick H. Schilling, 71, of Indianapolis, passed away December 23, 2021. Rick is survived by his three loving children, Stephanie, Lara, and Dustin Schilling. He was preceded in death by his parents, Harold and Beatrice (Naue) Schilling.

Rick was born in Indianapolis on April 4, 1950. He graduated from Franklin Central High School in 1968, where he led the school band as a drum major. He had great aptitude for mechanics and sales and spent years working for Sears Auto Center and Mack Trucks prior to starting his own company in 1986. He proudly owned and operated Maximum Truck Parts for the past 35 years.

Rick was passionate about drag racing and spent many Indiana summers racing his 1969 Chevy Nova at local tracks. By the end of high school, he had saved enough of his wages from Burger Chef to purchase his first custom muscle car. He dedicated himself to learning how to work on, convert, and race cars— even winning the Super Chevy Show drag races at Indianapolis Raceway Park in 1983. In addition to cars and racing, he enjoyed cruising the countryside on his Norton 850 Commando motorcycle.

Rick will be remembered and beloved by many for his sharp wit and warm demeanor. A dependable man, he was admired for the hard work and dedication he brought to any task at hand. He would make friends at first meeting simply by being himself (and often winning them over with his endearingly wry sense of humor). He will be greatly missed by his three
