Robert D. Adams, of the Geist Community was born February 22, 1935 in Winchester, Kentucky and died at Community Hospital in Indianapolis. He was the son of George and Georgia Nixon Adams, who have preceded in death. Bob was a graduate from University of Kentucky in Electrical Engineering and was an Indiana certified Professional Engineer.
