Robert V. ♦Bob♦ Belding, 90, Indianapolis, died December 19, 2007. Born in Indianapolis, Indiana on July 26, 1917, Bob married Tommie Frances Eubanks on February 21, 1943. Bob served in the United States Air Force (stationed in the Philippines) during World War II, retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel before joining the Reserves. Bob taught for 37 years for IPS, spending most of his time at Arsenal Tech High School as a math teacher, head of the math department, and vice principal. He also spent several years teaching math at Howe High School. He graduated from Tech High School, and Purdue University, with a graduate degree from Columbia University. Bob was a contributing editor on several mathematics textbooks during his years as an educator. Bob was a life-long member at Centenary Christian Church (DOC) where his parents were charter members. He was recently recognized for teaching Sunday School for 55 years. He also served as an elder, board chair, and choir member. His beloved wife, Tommie, preceded him in death in 1985. Surviving family members include son Steve Belding (Linda,) and daughter Anita Holder (Roger.) Grandchildren include Shari Jacobs (Ted,) Brent Belding (Amanda,) Craig Holder (Hasmig,) and Lori Herring (Jason.) Great-grandchildren include Rachael and Kara Jacobs, Griffin and Gray Belding, Morgan and Mollie Herring, and Bennett Holder.
