He enlisted in the Army in 1964 and served in Vietnam in 1966. His last post was Fort Carson, Colorado, where he met Glenda Windle at the USO. Bob was discharged in 1967 and in October of that year he and Glenda were married in Colorado Springs, and then settled in Indianapolis.

Bob worked various jobs but his chosen profession was an officer for the Indiana Department of Corrections. He worked at the women's facility for three years and the remainder of his 30 year career at Pendleton. Bob loved to fish, go for a drive or motorcycle ride, and bargain hunt at auctions.
