Loving husband, father, grandfather, and friend passed away November 27, 2018. He was born August 21, 1928 in Ferdinand, IN, the son of the late Otto and Clara Boeglin. Bob attended Huntingburg High School where he excelled in academics and athletics.

Bob began a lifelong association with Indiana University and graduated in 1950 from the School of Business. He was called to service in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. Bob was proud to have served as a Counter-Intelligence Agent in Europe where he worked to expose East European and Russian spies. He was honorably discharged as a Staff Sergeant in 1953. After completing his military service, Bob met and married Mary Cain in 1955. He enjoyed a long and notable career in the fields of mortgage banking, municipal finance and financial consulting. Bob was also an active participant in a wide variety of trade and civic organizations, especially the Indianapolis Jaycees and the Service Club of Indianapolis.
