Robert C. "Bob" Dhonau, 81, of Indianapolis, passed away suddenly December 2, 2015. He was born February 23, 1934 to the late Walter and Hazel Dhonau. Bob grew up in Carthage, IN, and served his country in the U.S. Air Force. He attended Butler University where he became a member of Sigma Chi Fraternity and later became a "Life Loyal Sig". Bob retired as Vice President of the mortgage division of First Indiana Bank after 30 years of service.
