Robert Daily Kaeser, SMSgt USAF (RET) age 98 years, of Indianapolis, passed away October 5, 2012. He was born March 10, 1914 in Berne, IN to the late John Fritz and Minnie Mae Martz Kaeser. Robert graduated from Wilshire (OH) High School and joined the U. S. Army serving from 1931 through 1940. He then served his country in the U. S. Air Force from 1942, retiring in 1960.
