



Rogers Ray "Roger" Schutt

August 21, 1921 - February 20, 2013

91 years of age, passed from this life February 20, 2013. He was born August 19, 1921 to Rayman L. and Veda Marie Rogers Schutt, who have preceded him in death. A lifelong resident of Indianapolis, Roger graduated from Arsenal Tech High School and received his degree in Civil Engineering from Purdue University. He served his country in the U. S. Navy, Construction Battalion, during WW II, and drove the beaches of Normandy and the islands of the South Pacific. He married Alice Jane Thompson, January 5, 1947, and she preceded him in death, March 15, 2012. Roger was the president of R. L. Schutt Construction Co. and the co-owner of Flasher Barricade & Lite Co. He was a longtime member of Irvington Presbyterian Church and Hillcrest Country Club.
