



## Rose Marie Priller

December 25, 1918 - April 25, 2008

Rose Priller, 89, of Indianapolis, passed away April 25, after an extended illness. She was born December 25, 1918 in Toledo, OH to Raymond and Margaret Mullenbach Gueutal, who have preceded her in death. Rose graduated from St. Agnes Academy in Indianapolis in the Class of 1936, and was a graduate of Marian College. She married Edward F.
