Rose Corbin Wheatley,

69, of Carthage, passed away March 16, 2019. She was born January 9, 1950 in Indianapolis to the late Hester D. and Alice R. Matthews Corbin. Rosie was a graduate of Manual High School and married Robert E. Wheatley, February 26, 1972. She was a homemaker and a special needs Teachers Aid for Carthage Elementary School for 10 years. Rosie had a passion for quilting. She was president of the Spring Valley Quilting Guild, taught quilting courses at the local library, and made raffle quilts to benefit children in Southeast Asia for the past two decades. She was also a strong advocate for military veterans.
