Rosemary Agnes (Queen) Ledgerwood, 95, formerly of 1504 Grand Avenue, Washington, IN, died December 3, 2015 in Fishers, IN, where she had moved in 2009. Rosemary was born December 11, 1919, in Washington, IN to William M. and Mary Terese (Spaulding) Queen. After graduating from Washington Catholic High School in 1937, Rosemary worked for the Buzan Insurance Agency and later with Citizens Insurance Agency.
