Roy J. Pellegrin, 77, of Fishers, Indiana, passed away May 25, 2021. He was born May 19, 1944 in Houma, Louisiana to the late Reuben and Velma (Blanchard) Pellegrin. Roy will be forever remembered as a man who loved, supported, and cherished his family – especially being Papa to his 5 grandkids. His circle of friends grew along with his years. From his Air Force buddies and hunting and fishing friends to his ever-supportive neighbors, Roy's heart was full when he was with them. Interacting with them was a highlight of his recent days. Professionally, he was a veteran of the United States Air Force where he served for seven years. After his service, Roy rose to Vice President of Engineering Research Inc. In 1973, he started and ran his own engineering firm, Automated Electronics Co., for over thirty-three years. Roy was a member of Holy Spirit at Geist Parish and Knights of Columbus and was the Past President of the Numerical Control Society and past Treasurer of the American Military Heritage Foundation.
