Sara Louise (Miller) Lantz, 83, of Fishers, passed away December 19, 2024. Sara Lou was born July 29, 1941 in Lexington, Kentucky to the late Robert R. and Lillian G. (Gribbin) Miller. She graduated from South Side High School, Fort Wayne, and received her bachelor's degree in education from Indiana University, where she was a member of Delta Gamma Sorority.
