Sheryl Kay Shepherd, 79, lifelong resident of Indianapolis, passed away December 3, 2024. She was born September 26, 1945 to the late Bob and Kay (Havens) Shepherd. Sheryl was a graduate of Arlington High School where she was Miss Junior Achievement. She received her bachelor's degree from Herron School of Art and her master's degree in education from Butler University. Sheryl began her career in teaching at IPS, and then as an elementary art teacher at Nora Elementary School for 42 years. She was an art teacher for the Indianapolis JCC and taught cultural arts for the Summer Program at Pike Township. Sheryl was a longtime member of Christ Church Cathedral. She was a member of O.E.S Englewood Chapter #783 where she was a past Worthy Matron, and a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma, Delta Kappa Gamma, and Alpha Delta Kappa Philanthropic Sororities. In 1990, Sheryl was awarded teacher of the year and was a volunteer for the Assistance League of Indianapolis.
