Stanley H. Nash, 87, of Fishers, IN, passed away October 8, 2024. He was born January 30, 1937 in Lakeside, Michigan to the late Stanley J. and Anna J. (Weider) Nash. Stanley was a graduate of New Buffalo High School, New Buffalo, MI. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army and married Joan Lenore Burns August 24, 1963. Stanley was employed in warehouse logistics and management for 40 years and retired from Pearson Education in 2003. Stanley had an unwavering commitment to his faith, family, and country. Stanley was a founding member of St. Louis de Montfort Catholic Church where he and Joan were instrumental in forming the first CYO group. His love for baseball and his love for his children and grandchildren led him to coaching countless baseball and softball teams throughout his lifetime.
