Stuart L. Warner, 83, Indianapolis, passed away March 13, 2010. He was born January 21, 1927 in Richmond, Indiana, the son of the late H. Pat and Blanche Carmen Warner. A resident of Indianapolis since age 4, Stuart attended Grade School 62 and graduated from Howe High School. He attended Indiana and Butler Universities, where he was affiliated with Kappa Sigma Fraternities. He also attended Indiana University Extension. Stuart joined State Farm Insurance Company in 1948, then served in the U. S. Army on active duty from 1950 until 1952, returning to State Farm, where he retired in 1994, after 45 years as a representative. He was a Steward for the American Horse Show Association, officiating at many regional and state shows in the 1960s and 70s. Stuart was a member of the Sertoma Club of East Indianapolis, serving on its Board of Directors, and was actively involved in its fundraising and charitable events until his illness in May 2002. Past memberships included the Indiana Athletic Club, Evergreen Masonic Lodge #500, F. & A. M., Scottish Rite, Murat Shrine and its T&S Club, where he also served as its President. Stuart was life member of ATA and served on ITA's Board of Directors for many years and ultimately as its President. He also belonged to the Okoboji Indian Organization and was a member of Irvington Presbyterian Church.
