Susan Ione Weida, Rossville, Indiana, died peacefully on June 28, 2008 in Milner Nursing Home with her devoted caretaker, Christy McGill, at her bedside. Ione was born on March 8, 1911 in the family home on Main Street in Rossville. Her parents, Mabel May Snyder and William Mayne predeceased her. Ione attended Rossville Schools and, as a young woman, worked in her uncle's bakery and her parents' grocery store. She married Bon D. Weida on March 1, 1931 and together they owned what was formerly the Sanitary Lunch in Rossville. Bon died in 1994. She was a homemaker for her entire life and had the greatest joy taking care of her home, baking and gardening. After her children moved away she helped Bon in the restaurant. During her life Mrs. Weida was a member of the Presbyterian and Methodist churches in Rossville. She was able to live in her home with caretaker and neighbor support for over 96 years. Mrs. Weida is survived by her son, Jerry Weida, M.D. (Patti Morton), West Lafayette, Indiana and their children, Jerry M. Weida II (wife, Danielle), Cristie A. Erb (husband, Eric), James R. Weida (fiance, Jennifer Pratt), all of Lafayette, Indiana, Amy L. Karlaftis (husband, Matt) of Athens, Greece, and John P. Weida (wife, Jennifer) of Indianapolis, Indiana; her son, Bill Weida, M.D. (Jane Davis), Shorewood, WI, and their children, Kathy and Samantha. There are nine great-grandchildren.
