Suzanne "Suzie" Roberts,

90, of Indianapolis, passed away May 22, 2020. She was born June 22, 1929 to the late Thomas and Elizabeth (Ragsdale) Moshenrose. She was the second child out of four and always had the "middle child" syndrome which drove everyone crazy when she would mention it.

She graduated from "IPS school 78" and then Howe High School. She worked several jobs but wanted some excitement. On February 14, 1950 she enlisted in the United States Navy and began a love affair with the Navy that would last the rest of her life. She was sent to Memphis, Tennessee for further training and then to Pensacola, Florida where she worked on the Admiral's staff. Her fondest memories were during this time. Now it was time to start a new adventure, she volunteered to be a "flight orderly". She had never been on an airplane in her whole life and before she knew it, she was flying over the Atlantic Ocean to such places as Portugal, Azore Island, Greenland, Cuba and South Africa. It was during one of these flights that she met a radioman named Robbie Roberts. They were married in 1953 at which time she resigned from the Navy. After they served 20 years in the Navy as husband and wife, they retired and moved to Indianapolis. She went to work at RCA in 1966 as a file clerk. She worked her way up to become the first female manager in computer operations in RCA history. She retired from RCA in 1988 after 20 years of service. She never forgot a birthday of all her nieces and nephews for over 25 years and also enclosed the famous dollar bill. She was

well known for sending all sorts of cards to family and friends. Suzanne was very close to her brother and sisters, Mary Jane and Nancy. She loved her family more than life itself.

Suzanne is survived by her daughters; Jane Roberts and Barbara A. Stroud (Jack); son, Pete Roberts (Jennifer); grandchildren, Andrew Stroud, Brian Stroud, Joseph Roberts and Emily Roberts; sister, Nancy Maley. She is preceded in death by her loving husband of 52 years, William Roberts; sister, Mary Jane Mattingly; and brother, Charles Moshenrose.
