Tatsuko Machida Hendrix, 95, of Fishers, Indiana passed away peacefully on November 27, 2023. She was born February 22, 1928 in Kyushu, Japan to the late Shigeo Machida and Take Uchida. After WWII Tatsuko was employed by the U.S. Military as a waitress at an Officers Club, then as a salesperson at a Post Exchange. During the Korean War she worked at a Marine Air Base as a housekeeper for Squadron Commanders. In 1955 one Squadron Commander invited her to visit he and his family in Wichita, Kansas, where she met her future husband, David Thomas Hendrix. They were married 67 years. After coming to America and Tatsuko was employed with Continental Baking Company, owned by Hostess/Wonder Bread. She was an amazing wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother.
