Terrence P. "Terry" Pickett,

76, of Indianapolis, passed away March 19, 2015. He was born July 7, 1938 in Kalamazoo, MI, to the late Peter, Jr. and Kathleen Bannigan Pickett. Terry was a graduate of St. Augustine High School. He received his Bachelor's Degree from University of Michigan, and his Masters of Public Administration from the University of Oklahoma. Terry served his country in the U.S. Army. He married Katharine R. Kraus on April 7, 1973.

Terry was an auditor for the Federal Government for 35 years, retiring in 1995. He was a member of Holy Spirit at Geist Catholic Church, and a past member of St. Lawrence Catholic Church where he served on the Parish Finance Committee. Terry was a member of the Lawrence Sertoma Club for over 30 years, and a past President. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council #3433, an 8 year member of Rock Steady Boxing, past President of the Association of Government Accountants, a 20 year volunteer at the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and past CFO, and a 10 year volunteer at the Children's Museum.
