THEODORE N. POPOFF Died August 1, 2008, age 85. A lifelong resident of Indianapolis, Theodore was graduated from Arsenal Technical High School and Butler University Class of 1946, where he was a member of Delta Tau Delta fraternity. Theodore served in the US Army during World War II. Theodore started his career as a junior high school teacher of English and Social Studies in the Indianapolis public schools, then moved to office manager for the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railroad. Following that, he worked for the Indiana State Department of Employment and Training Services as Executive Director of the State Occupational Information Coordinating Committee. Ted was involved in many local organizations in various capacities: OASIS, Historic Landmarks Foundation, Indiana Repertory Theater, Greater Church Foundation of Indiana, Sertoma Club of East Indianapolis, and the Shepherds Center. He was an active supporter of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra, and the Indiana Repertory Theatre. Ted was very involved with the Episcopal Church, having been a member of several churches over the years, serving in most lay capacities. He was last a member of St. Alban's Episcopal Church, where he served as a lay reader, chalice administrator, greeter, and in other functions. Funeral services will be held at St. Alban's Episcopal Church, 4601 North Emerson Ave., Indianapolis, IN 46226, on Saturday, August 16, 2008, with viewing and visitation from 11AM to 1PM, and service at 1PM.
