Thomas L. DeVol, 86, Indianapolis, passed away Monday, January 15, 2007. Born April 12, 1920 in Arcadia, IN, Thomas graduated from Anderson College and served in the U.S. Army during WWII. He worked as an instructor at General Motors Institute and retired from the Indiana State Department of Natural Resources, where he was Safety Director.
