September 5, 1956 - January 20, 2015

Thomas Bradford Galloway, 58, of Indianapolis, passed away peacefully on January 20, 2015, with family by his side. He was born September 5, 1956 to Leonora Ross and Arthur DeHaven Galloway, both of whom preceded him in death. He is survived by his two brothers, David (Jan) and Jim (Lisa) Galloway; and two sisters, Elly Johnston (David) and Kathy Lindsey; many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews.

Tom brightened everyone's day by simply being in the room, and he enjoyed spending time with his friends and housemates, Ross and "T". He also enjoyed fraternizing with any police officers that crossed his path, and flirting with the pretty ladies that made his acquaintance.

Tom was a devoted fan of Steak 'n Shake and loved going to the Friendly Tavern for dinner with his family on weekend visits. He religiously watched

Channel 6 News on a daily basis, and forecasting the weather was a passion of his. A true Hoosier, Thomas loved the Indianapolis 500, and made annual treks out to the track to take in the festivities. The Colts, Pacers, and Indiana University athletics all received Tom's unwavering support.
