Thomas D. Seeley,

Went to the Lord April 10, 2021, after a lengthy illness. He was born November 17, 1934 to Thomas and Genevieve (nee Curry) Seeley in Colorado Springs, CO. Tom graduated from Palmer High School in 1952, and received a B.S. in Political Science from the University of Colorado, Boulder. He served in the U.S. Army on both active duty and in the reserves, reaching the rank of Captain. While attending graduate school at Georgetown University he served in the congressional office of his state representative. After working for GE for three years, in 1962, he joined Dow Chemical Co. in sales and marketing, eventually transferring to Indianapolis as General Sales Manager.

Tom and Evelyn Grimm were married in 1963. He was a member of Cornerstone Lutheran Church and loved the church. After retirement from Dow, Tom and Evelyn travelled extensively, which they thoroughly enjoyed. Tom was a Rotarian for almost 40 years and served in several capacities. He volunteered for Executive Service Corps, and became an advisor for non-profits. In addition, he volunteered at the Eiteljorg Museum, and was involved in Indianapolis Zoo activities. Tom enjoyed golf and was a member of Crooked Stick for several years.

Tom is survived by his wife of 57 years, Evelyn; sons, Mark and David; grandson, Jordan; brother, Dick (wife Miki) and four cousins: Jennielou Bowen, Linda Hunter, Julie Coryell-Martin and Anne Kelly.

“ Tom, for me, was the family's Gregory Peck--handsome and classy with a great voice.

Our connection was through his uncle, my dad (the family's Bob Hope), who served on the U.S.S. Indianapolis on its last voyage. Tom would add to my collection of Indy stuff by sending local newspaper articles pertaining to the ship and its crew. He and Ev would tell me details my dad shared with them that I didn't know. I was able, armed with the information they provided and one book in particular, to track my dad's trip, almost minute by minute through Peal Harbor, trying to reboard the ship after an emergency doctor's appointment on shore. Luckily, he missed his connections--twice--or I probably wouldn't be here.

Tom was genuinely sincere and giving. When my husband passed, he and Ev called to express their condolences and asked if there is anything he could do. I felt his sincerity: I really felt that if I asked for the moon, he would simply ask 'which crater?'

I will miss his voice, his soft chuckle when we spoke on the phone, his handwritten notes and Christmas cards. I will miss his caring about this shirttail relative, not close in age but in heart mostly because of his reaching out for me and my family.

My appreciation and prayers for healing for Ev, Mark, et al for taking such great care of Tom. My condolences for our family and Tom and Ev's friends. May we all rest in knowing that he "fought the good fight, finished his course and kept the faith."
