December 22, 1930 - December 13, 2014

Victor R. Levine, MD, ScD, PhD, MPH, 83, of Fishers, passed away December 13, 2014. He was born December 22, 1930 in Simferopol, Russia, to Raphael and Cecilia Vinograd Levine. Victor graduated with a PhD from the Russian Medical School and a ScD from the Moscow Tuberculosis Institute. He completed a fellowship at Chapel Hill Medical School and received his MPH from the University of Alabama Medical School. After immigrating to the USA with his wife in 1980, he successfully passed his American medical boards. Victor was a physician for the Marion Veteran's Medical Center and conducted research for the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, Atlanta, Georgia.

Victor was a member of the American Medical Association. As a prolific author, he had many articles accepted by scientific and professional journals. He most recently authored the book "Global Economics, The Age of Balanced Capitalism".
