Virginia E. Luzader,

95, of Fishers, passed away January 23, 2024. She was born February 2, 1928, in Owen County, Indiana, to the late Conda and Alta Mae (Zegafuse) Rodman. Virginia was a 1945 graduate of Arsenal Technical High School. She received her bachelor's degree in 1949, and master's degree in 1953 from Butler University. Virginia married Herbert Luzader, August 7, 1949 and he preceded her in death August 12, 2017 after 68 years of marriage.

Virginia began her career in education teaching at IPS School #15 from 1949-1954. She then taught at Carmel Elementary School from 1965-1970, and Woodbrook Elementary School from 1970 until retirement in 1990. Virginia was a longtime member of Carmel Christian Church. When her sons were young, she was a Cub Scout Den Mother, a docent for the Carmel Clay Historical Society Museum, and past president of the Indiana Retired Teachers Association.

Visitation will be Saturday, January 27, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. until the time of service at 12 noon at Shirley Brothers Fishers-Castleton Chapel, 9900 Allisonville Road, Fishers.
