



## Werner Kriegsmann

They both found employment in Indianapolis, settled on the east side, and eventually worked for the former Western Electric phone company. Both retired in 1982. Several local radio stations supported this program including the student operated stations at The University of Indianapolis and Butler University. Werner was also active in the various German clubs and organizations in Indianapolis such as the Liederkranz and the German American Klub.
