Wesley Earl Kaiser was called home by the Lord on April 15, 2016 after a life-long struggle with alcoholism. He is survived by his children, Joseph and Haley, his children's mother, Jennifer Kaiser, mother Joy Kaiser, father Fred Kaiser (Sarah), sister Wendy Hines (Jason), sister-in-law Kimberly Tenholder (Brian), sister-in-law Kristin Oliphant (Michael), nieces Kylie Haas and Isabelle Hines, nephews Matthew Hines, Caleb, Andrew, and Zachary Oliphant, along with many aunts, uncles, cousins, as well as friends. He was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents Elsie Fern and Joseph Solenberg and paternal grandparents Laurretta and Wilber Kaiser. Although alcoholism ultimately took his life, he was so much more than his addiction. Wes graduated from New Palestine High School in 1989, however, he was a Warren Central Warrior at heart. He was a father to Joe and Haley and a father-figure to many. He was a son, grandson, brother, brother-in-law, uncle, nephew, cousin, friend, mechanic, and badminton king. He enjoyed 4-wheeling, Colts football, gardening, bird watching, collecting stray animals, music, Nascar, IU basketball, the New York Yankees, and he was a die-hard Republican. One of his greatest attributes was connecting with children of all ages. The patience he showed with kids, whether his own or others, touched the lives of many. Wes fought his battle with alcoholism every day for nearly 30 years. Although he ultimately lost the war, in his 45 years he loved, he laughed, and he lived, and we were all lucky enough to be a part of his journey.
