Wilbur A. Davis, Jr.

99, of Indianapolis, passed away peacefully April 1, 2024. He was born May 24, 1924 in Greenfield, IN, to the late Wilbur A., Sr. and Myla M. (Ging) Davis. Wilbur was a 1942 graduate of Thomas Carr Howe High School. He received his bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from Purdue University in 1945 where he was a member of the Triangle Fraternity, the Purdue All American Marching Band, and the ROTC. Wilbur proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1945-1947 and retired from the Naval Reserves in 1972 having attained the rank of Commander. He married Beverly A. Davis, and she preceded him in death November 30, 2017, after 65 years of marriage.

Wilbur began his career in electrical engineering with Indiana Bell in the Engineering Department and the Comptroller's Department, eventually retiring as Director of Business Research in 1986, after 40 years of service. He was a member of the Scottish Rite, the Purdue Alumni All American Marching Band where he was active in the Homecoming Parades, and a volunteer with Boy Scouts of America, receiving the Silver Beaver Award at the Council Level for distinguished service.

Wilbur is survived by his children, John A. Davis (Paula), Gregg E. Davis (Kris), and Kaley Davis; and grandsons, John Michael and Anthony Davis. He was preceded in death by his sister, Charlene Marquis.
