



William "Bill" Emerson Bramell

February 5, 1941 - September 15, 2024

William "Bill" Emerson Bramell, Indianapolis, 83, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by loved ones, on September 15, 2024. He left behind a legacy of love, friendship and cherished memories. He was born February 5, 1941 in Indianapolis to the late Oscar Davis and Lucille (Fuller) Bramell. Bill was a graduate of Scecina Memorial High School and attended Purdue University.

Bill is survived by his loving wife of 59 years, Velma Mae Bramell; daughters, Jeannine Breiner (Jon), Karen Callaway (Bill), and Kelli Moore (Daniel); 15 grandchildren; 19 great-grandchildren. He is also survived by his older brother, James Donald "Pete" Bramell and sister-in-law, Mary Kay Bramell. He is preceded in death by his parents and his beloved daughter, Lori Ann Creech.

Bill and Velma shared a lifetime of joy and partnership and together, they raised four daughters and built a beautiful family. Bill will be fondly remembered by his daughters who remember him as a wonderful father who coached their softball teams, took them camping, canoeing and fishing and created countless memories through the YMCA Indian Princess father and daughter tribes. His love for the outdoors and his commitment to family adventures left an enduring legacy.

Professionally, Bill worked most of his adult life as a computer programmer in the 1970s and 1980s, a time when computer technology was just emerging. His technical expertise and problem-solving skills placed him at the forefront of a rapidly evolving industry. Bill concluded his career at Franklin Township Community School Corporation, where he worked for 18 years before retiring in 2005. His dedication and contributions to his profession were highly regarded.

Bill was a lifelong fan of the Green Bay Packers, who could often be heard cheering “Go Pack Go!” and made many trips to Lambeau Field to support his beloved team. Bill’s wonderful sense of humor and quick wit defined his personality and brought joy to those around him. His hard work ethic, honesty and strong morals were legendary, earning him the respect and admiration of everyone who knew him. Bill’s values were a guiding force in his life and a lasting gift to his family and friends.

In addition to his passion for football, Bill was an avid bowler, participating in numerous leagues throughout his life. His competitive spirit also shone in his love for golf, which he enjoyed on many courses with his friends during his retirement. Known affectionately for his signature “Billy Bounce” golf hits (a humorous nod to his unique way of getting the ball back on course), Bill’s lighthearted approach made him a beloved companion on the greens. Bill’s love of cards was another defining aspect of his life. An expert euchre player, Bill’s competitive nature passed down from his mother, was well known among his many card groups and parties where his skill and humor were always appreciated.

Bill’s life was a testament to love, loyalty, integrity and the value of deep relationships. He will be profoundly missed, but his memory will live on through the stories, laughter and love shared by his family and friends.

His family will forever remember the love, laughter and memories that were shared together and his passing reunites him with those he dearly loved.
