William S. Fabianic,

In 1957 he joined the Navy and was commissioned as a Civil Engineer Corps Officer, serving tours in Norfolk, VA; Philippines; McAlester, OK; Vietnam; and Indianapolis. After leaving the Navy, Bill spent 25 years as a design and project engineer working with meteorological measurement systems.

Bill was involved with scouting over the years, achieving the rank of Eagle Scout and serving as a Scoutmaster and Explorer Advisor. He had strong interests in photography and computers. Bill became an avid motorcyclist traveling around and across the United States. After his retirement, he enjoyed traveling to Southeast Asia, Slovenia, Croatia, Budapest, and the Caribbean Islands.
