



## William Rolland Fry

September 29, 1936 - April 5, 2009

William R. Fry, 72, of Carmel and Las Vegas, passed away Sunday morning, April 5, 2009. Fry, a native of Winamac, Indiana, attended Indiana University, and was president of his senior class in 1958, president of his fraternity, Sigma Chi, and a member of the ROTC. After graduation, he served 5 years in the Army at Ft. Jackson, SC, and in South Korea. After the Army, Bill joined AFNB, and in 1983 left the bank and started his own investment management firm, Progressive United. In 1992, Bill moved to Shreveport, Louisiana to purchase and run radio stations. After selling the radio stations in 1999, Bill spent his time managing investments from his residence in Las Vegas, NV. In 2008, he returned to Carmel, Indiana to spend time with his family.
